Note 1: New skippers (either 5-Day or 7-Day) for the Catalina 27 (called Zephyr) are automatically entitled to two onboard classes covering the skills and responsibilities for skippering and maintaining a 27-foot keelboat.

Note 2 - Special Appeal from the Keelboat Committee: If we relied only on fees from dues and passes, the fund to provide for the eventual replacement of the keelboat Zephyr would not be fully funded until 2038.
